Project Location: The project is located on RD 307/Lisbon District, on Sacramento River, Babel Slough, and Winchester Slough in the city of Clarksburg in Yolo County, California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0366-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Reclamation District No. 307.

The project is limited to the routine maintenance activities on Lisbon District. Maintenance activities includes clearing of debris and vegetation, including sediments and rocks, from water and flood control devices, removal of flood-deposited woody or herbaceous vegetation and associated debris which significantly reduces channel capacity, cleaning, repairing, raising, modification of an replacement of flap gates, discharge pipes, siphons, weirds, drop structures, or other existing water control devices; repairing levees, including placement of riprap, to correct minor slipouts, erosion, or subsidence of the levee section; removal or deposits of soil, debris, rubbish, litter, and similar maters from channels, levees, and berms; repairing and shaping of patrol or access roads on levees; control of vegetation on the waterside slopes of levees by trimming or treating with approved herbicides; removal or modification of encroachments; and rodent control, including extermination and burrow in-fill, conducted in accordance with Fish and Game codes and any Department regulation.
