from 2,669 linear feet of the riparian corridor along an unnamed tributary to Soda Creek. Project 2 consists of
revegetation of 0.44 acres of riparian vegetation along creek that burned in wildfire. Replanting with native plants
will stabilize banks, reduce sedimentation and provide riparian cover
