Project Title: Reestablish Amargosa Voles in Shoshone Village, Inyo County

Project Location (include county): The Project is located at Shoshone Village. Invo County (35°58.19'N 116°16.35W) adjacent to Old Highway 178, 0.5 miles north of the intersection of State Route 167 and State Route 178. Ancillary project sites include two marshes (35°53.00'N 116°14.01W and 35°52.85'N 116°13.90W) near Tecopa, Inyo County.

Project Description:

Exempt Status:

The project will capture and translocate between three and six pairs of the state and federally listed as endangered, wild-caught Amargosa Voles (Microtus californicus scirpensis) into restored habitat on private land near Shoshone Village. The project will minimize impacts to the donor populations by removing surplus individuals at the time of maximum seasonal abundance under the terms of a federal recovery permit. Use of proven handling techniques will minimize the chance of injury or loss to translocated individuals. The receiving property owner, and the source property owner US Bureau of Land Management are full partners in the project. Amargosa voles currently occupy approximately 75 acres of suitable habitat within a 1.5-mile radius of Tecopa, but have been absent from their former habitat in and near Shoshone Village for over 100 years. The project will establish an independent, geographically separate, second population of Amargosa Voles, to better secure the subspecies from extinction.
