The project involves the restoration and ordinary maintenance of segments of an existing hiking trail to its original condition; no new trails or widening beyond the original conditions will occur. This will be accomplished with hand tools, and where necessary, chain saws to cut tress that have fallen on top of the trail; all work will be performed by people; no motorized equipment, except chainsaws, will be utilized to remove plant growth on and over the trail. In some places, fire-induced erosion has resulted in sections of the trail being covered or washed away. The trail will be contoured so that water flows naturally down the slopes in a manner that minimizes soil erosion. Hiker-oriented trail signs will be installed beside the trail to direct trail users to the footpath.

The purpose of South Fork Merced River Trail Restoration project is to improve its most heavily-used trail sections, involving about 10 miles. The objective of Spikes 1-2 (Bishop Creek) and Spikes 3-5 (Devil's Gulch) is to restore the trail multi-user and stock use, which will be achieved by: bucking and clearing --- downed trees; install 60 water drainage dips, repairing deferred maintenance by widening 5 miles of trail tread, and 10 miles of brushing and clearing 8 foot wide and 10 foot high to FS standards for all users including Stock. Remove trash from the camp area located at the terminus of the trail restored in the project. Necessary power tools include chain-saws. Partners in this work include the Sierra National Forest and Mariposa Trails volunteer group. There is no need for disposal of any cut materials; all materials will be incorporated into the site restoration.
