A Director's Order was issued to repair concrete girders at the Olivehurst Avenue Overcrossing (Bridge #16 0036) on Route 70 in Yuba County at PM R9.28. The scope of work includes replacement of the outer girder and repair of two other girders, removal and replacement of the bridge rails, pavement repairs, traffic control and incidental work. This project is needed to avoid the failure or threat of failure to the transportation system and to prevent or mitigate the loss or impairment of life, health, property and essential public services.		
All staging would take place within the Caltrans right-of-way. All work is within the Caltrans right-of-way. No borrow or disposal is required. No need for consultation or coordination. No permits are required.
