Phase 1 includes the construction of an 11,700 square foot storage shed and two (2) 6,300 square foot storage sheds. In addition, three (3) existing buildings totaling approximately 93,740 square feet will be used for storage and office space. The project also proposes to establish a railroad spur from the Stockton Terminal & Eastern Railroad. Phase 2 includes the construction of two (2) 8,400 square foot storage sheds. The parcel is served by California Water Service for water, a septic system for wastewater disposal, and storm water is to be drained to an existing lift station and pumped to the Stockton
