


NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF THE DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT/ ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR THE **NEVADA-49 CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT** PROJECT IN GRASS VALLEY

WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED:

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in coordination with Nevada County Transportation Commission, proposes to improve safety, operations, and mobility on State Route (SR) 49 in Nevada County from post mile 10.8 to R13.3. Project improvements include the addition of northbound and southbound truck climbing lanes, a 14'-22' median with barrier, 8'-10' shoulders, right turn lanes, two at-grade access-controlled intersections, improvements to vertical curve sight distance, a 12' x 12' animal crossing, and improvements from the Nevada County Active Transportation Plan, which identifies SR 49 as needing Class III bicycle facilities and providing adequate shoulders for disabled vehicles and California Highway Patrol enforcement activities. This project will be built in three phases of construction based on funding availability.
