

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to resurface, restore, and rehabilitate the roadway on State Route 119 from Ashe Road to the State Route 99/State Route 119 interchange in Kern County (post miles 28.2 to post miles 31.3).

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment, and our studies show that it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. This notice is to inform the public that an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared for the project and is now available for review and comments. This notice also offers the opportunity to request a public hearing.
