



Notice of Intent to Adopt a PROPOSED NEGATIVE DECLARATION and Opportunity for a Public Hearing

(Study Results Available)

State Route 88 Peddler Hill Soil Remediation



WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to construct a temporary generator building, demolish the existing generator building, and remediate soil underneath existing generator building at Peddler Hill Maintenance Station on State Route 88 at post mile 54.0 in Amador County.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Comments will be accepted from July 20, 2020 to August 19, 2020.

If there are no major comments or requests for a hearing, Caltrans will proceed with the project's design.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment.
