

Due to the waterline's age and material used, these sections of piping experience numerous leaks that require a large amount of maintenance as reported by the District's Operations staff. The pipeline replacement will improve the system hydraulics with the replacement of the existing 6-inch diameter waterlines in 53rd and 54th Street with the proposed 8-inch diameter waterlines and the existing 12-inch diameter waterline in Felspar St. will be replaced with a proposed 12-inch diameter waterline.
		The pipeline replacement will include approximately 3,387 feet of 8-inch diameter waterline from Beech Street to Felspar Street, 2,424 feet of 8-inch diameter waterline from Cedar Avenue to Felspar Street, and approximately 3,428 feet of 12-inch diameter waterline from 51st Street to 56th Street.
		The project consists of trenching, backfill and compaction work to facilitate the replacement of existing waterlines, replacement of existing water meter boxes, fire hydrants, air valves, and blow-offs, and connections to the existing water system. Restoration of surfaces such as pavements, sidewalks, curb/gutter, lawns and parkways will be performed as well as protection and support of existing above and below grade facilities and utilities.




Figure 1-1 Vicinity Map and Project Location
