

## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE GOLDEN TRIANGLE SEWER PIPELINE PROJECT

Public Review Period: July 24, 2020 to August 24, 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Eastern Municipal Water District (District) has completed an Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the proposed Golden Triangle Sewer Pipeline Project (Project) in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

The Project site is in the city of Murrieta immediately north of the Interstate 15 (I-15) and I-215 interchange. The northern terminus of the Project is located within the roadway of Sparkman Court just north of Murrieta Hot Springs Road. The proposed sewer pipeline then travels south through the approved Golden Triangle Project site and then crosses under I-15 utilizing trenchless technology, and then continues along Guava Street to the Madison Avenue intersection.

The Project consists of a sewer pipeline extension consisting of the following three segments:

- Segment 1: Murrieta Hot Springs Road Crossing Segment approximately 230-foot-long sewer extension;
- Segment 2: Golden Triangle Segment approximately 1,417-foot-long sewer extension; and
- Segment 3: I-15 Crossing Segment approximately 2,070-foot-long sewer extension.

The District would construct Segments 1 and 3, while Segment 2 would be constructed by the developer of the Golden Triangle Specific Plan. The sewer pipeline would be 15 inches in diameter, and construction would reach depths of excavation ranging from 15 - 25 feet. All manholes within the project site would be constructed within existing roadways or sidewalks.

The proposed project is not on a list compiled pursuant to Government Code Section 65962.5.

In accordance with Section 15072(a) of the CEQA Guidelines, the Public Notice officially notifies the general public, public agencies, and landowners that a 30-day public review period will begin on **Friday July 24, 2020**. Comments on the IS/MND should focus on environmental issues and must be
