Project Location (include county): The project is located within Oak Glen Creek, in the City of Yucaipa, County of San Bernardino, State of California; Latitude 34.01773, Longitude -117.09770. The project site is between the eastbound and westbound lanes of Interstate 10 (I-10), northwest of Live Oak Canyon Road, northeast of Outer 10 Highway S., and south of Dunlap Boulevard, within a small portion of Oak Glen Creek.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SBR-21776-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Michael Baker International.

The project is limited to conducting geotechnical boring activities in two locations within Oak Glen Creek: 1) boring A-002-2021 located at latitude 34.017730° and longitude -117.097610° 2) and boring A-003-2021 located at latitude 34.017690° and longitude -117.097580°. These borings are required as part of the preliminary geotechnical survey work to study soil conditions and design a bridge structure that will span over Oak Glen Creek and close the gap in the median between the I-10 eastbound and westbound directions.
