PROJECT DESCRIPTION

FRESNO IRRIGATION DISTRICT SAVORY POND PROJECT

The proposed project is for the construction of the FID Savory Pond groundwater basins on approximately 30 acres for the purpose of recharge. The District's Oleander No. 16 Canal runs through the northern portion of the parcel via a buried reinforced concrete culvert. The site consists of an existing 3.5± acre pond to the north of the existing Oleander No. 16 Canal culvert and approximately 20 acres to the south of the culvert which currently contains a storm drainage pond along with horse stables, small accessory structures, and fencing. Surface water is delivered to the existing pond via an inlet structure with a canal gate and an 18-inch diameter pipeline, located directly upstream of the culvert inlet headwall, to the pond's north corner. The canal also delivers surface water to the 3.5± acre pond via an inlet structure and 24-inch diameter pipeline to the pond's south corner. The inlet structure is located directly downstream of the Oleander No. 16 Canal culvert and utilizes a canal gate and long crested weir with flashboards for diversions. The Area of Potential Effect is approximately 30 acres and is located at the NW corner of Chestnut and Lincoln Avenues in Fresno County.
