**Project Title**: Ponce Pond and Stream Crossings (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0087-R1)

**Project Location:** The project to be completed is located within the Mad River watershed, approximately 3 miles northeast of the town of Dinsmore, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 36, T2N, R5E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Blake Mountain U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 208-241-011.

**Project Description:** The project is limited to 6 encroachments. Two proposed encroachments include upgrading undersized stream crossings. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly sized crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. Two encroachments include actively maintaining existing watercourse crossings. One encroachment includes construction of a spillway on an onstream pond. One encroachment is to remove diversion infrastructure from a spring.
