The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is proposing to install Wireless Detection Systems sensors, to install Variable Message Signs, to upgrade the Midwest Guardrail System, and to install Maintenance Vehicle Pullouts to assist with equipment maintenance along State Route 1 in San Mateo County. The project proposes to improve daily traffic management capabilities for Caltrans, cities, and first responders and to provide travel information to the traveling public.
