The project also includes the following secondary elements: Removal of up to seven trees, and work within the dripline of up to eight trees; Demolition of three residential buildings, one detached garage, and three shed structures; Roadway improvements along Olympic Boulevard; Installation of approximately 140 linear feet of 16-foot wide paved driveway; Establishment of a 20-foot Access and Utility Easement over Parcel-A; Establishment of a 5-foot public utility easement along the frontage of Parcel-A; Establishment of a 5-foot public utility easement on the parcel identified as 2055 Olympic Boulevard (APN: 184-302-004), to allow for underground stormdrain infrastructure extensions; New connections to existing water, stormdrain, and sanitary sever mains within Olympic Boulevard; Future construction of one single-family residence on each resultant parcel; Annexation into Community Facilities District 2010-1 for Countywide Street Light Financing
