


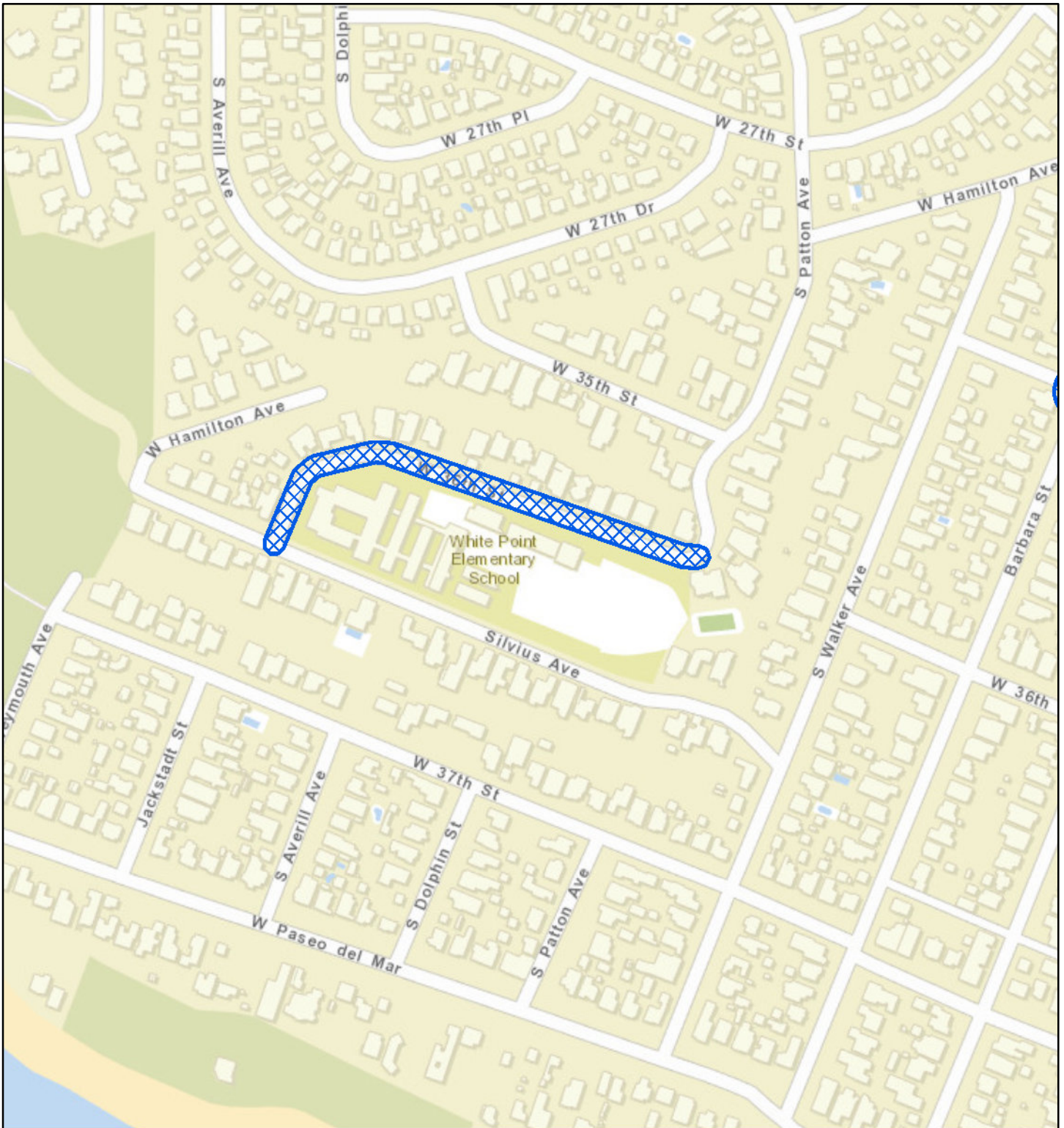
NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Submission of this form is optional. The form shall be filed with the County Clerk, 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, CA 90650, pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21152(b). Pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21168(d), the filing of this notice starts a 35-day statute of limitations on Court challenges to the approval of the project. Failure to file the notice results in the statute of limitations being extended to 180 days.

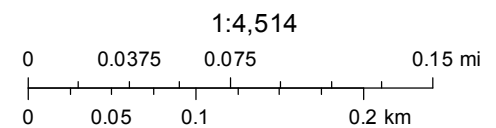

PROJECT LOCATION Replacing existing mainlines at residential streets in the coastal neighborhood of San Pedro, Los Angeles, California. Specifically, the project is located on 36th St., from Silvius Ave. to Patton Ave. See attached map for project location.			
DESCRIPTION OF NATURE, PURPOSE, AND BENEFICIARIES OF PROJECT: The LADWP is committed in providing safe and reliable source of water to its customers. Under LADWP's Water Infrastructure Plan, pipeline replacement projects promote long-term efficient operation and lower the risk of disruptions due to failures in the water distribution system. The proposed project would replace existing aging mainline pipes to provide a more reliable and safe water supply for the residents of this area. The proposed project replaces approximately 1,100 feet of aging mainline pipes placed back in 1949 and 1957 made of cast iron material, with ductile iron pipes in the location listed above. Construction each day will be confined to a small area between 50 feet to 100 feet long and move along the project alignment for the construction duration of approximately two months until completion. Excavated area will be covered with steel plates until the completion of each replaced pipe segment is backfilled and paved. Traffic control plans will be implemented per Los Angeles Department of Transportation requirements.

EXEMPT STATUS: CEQA California Public Resources Code Division 13, Chapter 2.6, Section 21080.21			
JUSTIFICATION FOR PROJECT EXEMPTION: In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) it has been determined that the proposed project, which replaces less than one mile of existing pipe meets the statutory exemption pursuant to Public Resources Code, Division 13, Chapter 2, Section 21080.20. Specifically, the section states the division does not apply to any project of less than one mile in length within a public street or highway or any other public right-of-way for the installation of a new pipeline or the maintenance, repair, restoration, reconditioning, relocation, replacement, removal or demolition of an existing pipeline. For the purpose of this section, "pipeline" includes subsurface facilities but does not include any surface facility related to the operation of the underground facility.
