NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday**, **January 26**, **2021**, starting at **9 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Joint Chambers, 1010 10th Street, Basement Level, Modesto, California, to consider the following:

PLANNING COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATION FOR APPROVAL OF <u>REZONE</u> <u>APPLICATION NO. PLN2020-0073 – ELUM, INC.</u> – Request to rezone a 5.7 acre parcel from Planned Development (P-D) 300 to a new Planned Development to allow for the operation of a labeling machine assembly and repair business in two phases. Phase 1 will include the use of an existing 15,126 square-foot building and Phase 2 proposes to construct a new building up to 25,000 square-feet in size. The project site is located at 4918 Taylor Court, between East Keyes and Taylor Roads, west of State Route 99, in the Keyes/Turlock area.

The property is further identified as Assessor's Parcel No.: 045-062-003

The Board of Supervisors will consider this project exempt under CEQA Guidelines Section 15061 (Common Sense Exemption).
