Project Title: Dry Creek Stream Restoration and Water Quality Improvement Project

Project Location: Dry Creek and associated Riparian Zone within Royer and Saugstad Parks, City of Roseville, CA.

Project Description: The Roseville Environmental Utilities Department Stormwater Division proposes implementation of a creek and riparian restoration and water quality improvement project. The project includes habitat enhancement over an approximately 1.3 acre site including creation of vegetated bioswales, sediment capture plantings, and increase bank stabilization (i.e., biotechnical plantings) to prevent further sedimentation and the loss of habitat within the Dry Creek watershed.

Agency Carrying Out Project: Roseville Environmental Utilities Department

Reason why this Project is Exempt: This project qualifies for a Class 33 Small Habitat Restoration Project Categorical Exemption as described in Section 15333 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines which states:

"Class 33 consists of projects not to exceed five acres in size to assure the maintenance, restoration, enhancement, or protection of habitat for fish, plants, or wildlife..."

The project is less than five acers and would be implemented consistent with applicable state and federal permit conditions designed to ensure no significant adverse impact to endangered, rare or threatened species or their habitat. The project includes revegetation and wetland creation/restoration activities carried out principally with hand labor using native vegetation and bioengineering techniques, with the primary purpose of reducing or eliminating erosion and sedimentation and improving aquatic and riparian wildlife habitat. Therefore the Class 1 Exemption is applicable to the proposed project.
