DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install two (2) new

pedestrian trail bridges along Moss Cove Trail in Point lobos State Natural Reserve to allow to visitor access to an important part of the Reserve's trail network. Work will:

- Remove 2 (two) existing failed clay culverts;
- Excavate soil to open up ephemeral drainage;
- Install 2 (two) wood gluelam pedestrian trail bridges with redwood decking and handrails, one to span 23' and the other to span 34' across the drainages.
