THE DEPARTMENT OF TOXIC SUBSTANCES CONTROL NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY (NOA) / NOTICE OF INTENT (NOI) TO ADOPT AN INITIAL STUDY / MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD BEVERLY HILLS

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the CEQA Guidelines, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) prepared a Draft Initial Study / Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) that identify and evaluate the environmental impacts of the Removal Action Workplan (RAW).

Project Title: Union Pacific Railroad Beverly Hills

Project Description: The preferred and recommended removal action alternative for the Site is a soil cover with Limited Excavation, Offsite Disposal, and Institutional Controls. Site specific removal action goals were selected based on approved DTSC cleanup guidelines and a soil cover will be installed over the remaining arsenic-impacted soil to limit direct contact between receptors and impacted soil, and to reduce storm water from disturbing the subsurface. Land Use Controls and Institutional Controls that restrict activities at the Site will be included.
