


Need for the Project and Description

The project scope is to provide an emergency backup generator at the City's existing lift station in the Irvine Cove Communication. The generator will be underground in a precast vault under the parking area at the top of the beach access stairs to Irvine Cove Beach. Construction access is proposed from the entrance to Irvine Cove.







CEQA Documentation - Categorical Exemption (CE)

The proposed project appears to qualify for at least one, and possibly two Categorical Exemptions (CE's):

Class 1 Categorical Exemption: Upgrade to an existing facility.

Class 3 Categorical Exemption: New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures.

Class 3 consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure. The numbers of structures described in this section are the maximum allowable on any legal parcel. Examples of this exemption include but are not limited to: (d) Water main, sewage, electrical, gas, and other utility extensions, including street improvements, of reasonable length to serve such construction.
