#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Existing Leach Field for Residence 4 and 5 in Portola Redwoods SP has failed. Exisiting Septic tank is in good condition; this proposal for is for the installation of a new drain field only. Currently one residence (#5) is vacant and is slated to be brough back online to house a parks resident who has been displaced by the CZU Lightnign Fire Complex.

Scope of work is as follows: Expose discharge pipe from septic tank. Abandon existing failed drain field and reroute discharge pipe around septic tank to access road. Excavate approximately 100' long, 24" wide and 6' deep trench along access road. The trench will be deep enough for 5' of drain rock below the 4" perforated drain pipe. The pipe will be covered by approximately 6" of drain rock and covered with filter fabric. The trench will then be back filled with the soil from the excavation and be compacted to avoid later settling. Excess soil will be spread out over access road and septic tank area to final grade. The project will require approximately 50 tons of 3/4" drain rock supplied by park. The drain field will have an inspection pipe to monitor the system at the far end of the drain field and brought up to grade. The inspection pipe will be accessible inside a 12" round Christy box.

All work to be performed outside of the Marbled Murrelet breeding season (March 24<sup>th</sup> -September 23<sup>rd</sup>). Trench will be located in an existing road alignment and will not impact vegetation or wildlife. Any large roots (3" wide or wider) will not be cut and soil will be excavated by hand. Soil spoil piles will be contained so as to avoid potential runoff into nearby creekbed.

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
