Phase II includes design, engineering and related studies, installation native landscaping, perimeter fencing and pedestrian walkways. Historic preservation actions are eligible activities under 24 CFR 570.202(d) as the site is a historic property under Section 106 and eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criteria A and listed in a State or local inventory of historic places, or designated as a State or local landmark.
