

The City of Palm Springs proposes to construct a new sewer main along Indian Canyon Drive from Tramview Road to Garnet Avenue. The sewer main will also cross under the Union Pacific Railroad tracks and within the new bridge structure. Manholes will be constructed along the sewer main alignment as well. The project is designed to provide public sewer service to the commercial and industrial area of Palm Springs .
