Re: Reaffirmation of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Compliance for Wastewater Treatment Plant Pond Reconfiguration and Land Application Expansion Area.

The City of Newman applied for and anticipates the receipt of a funding agreement for a wastewater infrastructure project to be administered through the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) loan program.
