DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Issue an Archeological Collections Permit (DPR 412) to a PhD student from the University of California Santa Cruz, to conduct archaeological research using ground-penetrating radar. Secondarily, collect botanical information from the site. Work will:

- Using GPR, produce multidimensional images of subsurface deposits without damage to resources;
- Use minimally invasive shovel test to see plant usage change of local Natives, disturbing about (150-200) liters of soil;

In addition, project consists of basic data collection, research, and resource evaluation activities, which do not result in a serious or major disturbance to an environmental resource; included as "Archaeological investigations by Department staff and permitted individuals/ universities" in the Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities in accordance with CCR 15300.4.
