Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The Staging Area Improvement project will involve cutting into the existing dirt road and adjacent slope approximately 20 feet to provide a paved parking area for approximately 10 vehicles and provide additional space for winter snowplows to safely operate. A 2:1 slope will be placed around the excavated area to stabilize the hillside and minimize erosion. This project will improve winter recreation access, public safety, and ongoing erosion issues by stabilizing and delineating the existing (informal) vehicle staging area and creating additional parking and egress (turn-around space) for snowplows and large vehicles. The project area is confined to a historic and existing disturbed area that currently serves as a de facto, non-formalized staging area for multiple recreation user groups who are accessing National Forest system lands from the town managed Shady Rest Park (under Special Use Permit from Inyo National Forest).
