Project Location (include county): The Project is located at an unnamed creek along State Route 26 near the North Fork Calaveras River, in the County of Calaveras, State of California. The post miles (PM) for this Project are CAL-26 PM 21.7 to 22.8.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number CAL-21204-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Project Applicant, California Department of Transportation.

The Project includes the installation of slope stabilization material, the construction of soldier pile walls (retaining walls), the construction of three retaining walls, the installation of four culverts, and the placement of rock slope protection (RSP) on the slopes of the creek. The Project is limited to vegetation clearing and grubbing, tree removal, placement of fill on the banks, drilling of the banks, grading of the banks, and concrete pouring.
