**Project Location:** The project is located at 6363 Jamison Road, Santa Rosa, on Matanzas Creek, in the County of Sonoma.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0220-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Ron Whitney.

The project is limited to the stabilization of approximately 90 linear feet of severely eroded stream bank along Matanzas Creek. The project will include a 3-foot deep keyway at the toe of the slope, and the bank above that will be laid back for approximately 30-feet at a 1.5:1 slope. Eighteen to 24-inch diameter rock riprap boulders will be placed starting in the keyway at the toe of the slope and extending 30-feet up the bank. Boulders will be interplanted with willow stakes for approximately the first 20-feet of the bank repair.
