DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Implement the North Grove Meadow Riparian Restoration Project (NGMRRP) to offset the impacts to the riparian habitat for the Big Tree Creek Stormwater Compliance Project (BTCSCP). Work will:

- Remove and control invasive plants and conifer saplings within and along the edge of the meadow;
- Fell and relocate hazard and/or dead trees located along the perimeter of the meadow to specific locations along western edge of the meadow;
- replant native trees, shrubs, and herbaceous plants along western edge of meadow; and
- construct approximately 20 brush boxes within the Big Tree Cree. The brush boxes consists of cut material from conifer sapling removal and are approximately $5-\mathrm{ft}$ wide $\times 1.5-\mathrm{ft}$ tall $\times 1-\mathrm{ft}$ depth.
