Additional work will include erosion control in the trail footprint and planting native vegetation. Exemption 15304 is for "minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes." A non-exclusive list of examples includes certain grading activities, filling activities, alterations that improve habitat for fish or wildlife, and fuel management to reduce fire risks.
