DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Geotechnical investigations are needed to acquire soil conditions and percolation rates to support the proper design of infrastructure for the Holmes Camp Water System Upgrade Project. This project includes upgrading the existing treatment system to provide for current and future use, and will include monitoring, controls, and additional equipment to meet California Dept. of Public Health and California Water Quality Control Board standards. The investigations include, but are not limited to, test pits to acquire soil samples for characterization and testing.
