PROJECT TITLE: ATV Track Sprinkler System

LOCATION: Carnegie State Vehicular Recreation Area **COUNTY:** San Joaquin

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install a sprinkler system to improve dust control efficiency, reduce cost, and free up valuable personnel time. Work will:

- Use excavator to excavate a trench approx. 1,530ft in length, 12in in width and 24in in depth;
- Install (5) volume sprinklers on the interior of the track;
- Install (5) 2-in hydrants below each sprinkler;
- Install (2) dwarf hydrants along the new water line;
- Use concrete truck to install a 10ft x 10ft x 6in concrete pad;
- Use dump truck to backfill trench with clean sand and excavated material;
- Tie new lateral water line into existing non-potable water source; and
- Install diesel generator and switch to operate pump.

This Notice of Exemption supersedes the previous one filed on 11/6/2020.
