This exemption applies to projects that consist of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. This exemption applies to the proposed supportive and transitional housing facility because it would operate within an existing single-family residence without any physical expansion of the existing structure. Therefore, the proposed project is categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA
