Driscoll Road Main Renewal Project- Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND)

Dear Dorota Budzynska:

Thank you for including the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in the environmental review process for the Driscoll Road Main Renewal Project. We are committed to ensuring that impacts to the State's multimodal transportation system and to our natural environment are identified and mitigated to support a safe, sustainable, integrated and efficient transportation system. The following comments are based on our review of the December 2020 draft MND.

Project Understanding

The proposed project proposes to replace approximately 7,400 feet of existing water pipeline along Driscoll Road and Paseo Padre Parkway. The project site terminates at the Mission Boulevard (State Route (SR)-238) and Driscoll Road intersection, within the Caltrans Right-of-Way (ROW).

Project-Related Impacts

Potential impacts to the ROW from project-related temporary access points during construction should be analyzed. Mitigation for significant impacts due to construction and noise should be identified. Project work that requires movement of oversized or excessive load vehicles on state roadways requires a transportation permit that is issued by Caltrans. 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Encroachment Permit

Please be advised that any permanent work or temporary traffic control that encroaches onto the ROW requires a Caltrans-issued encroachment permit. If any Caltrans facilities are impacted by the project, those facilities must meet American Disabilities Act (ADA) Standards after project completion. As part of the encroachment permit submittal process, you may be asked by the Office of Encroachment Permits to submit a completed encroachment permit application package, digital set of plans clearly delineating the State ROW, digital copy of signed, dated and stamped (include stamp expiration date) traffic control plans, this comment letter, your response to the comment letter, and where applicable, the following items: new or amended Maintenance Agreement (MA), approved Design Standard Decision Document (DSDD), approved encroachment exception request, and/or airspace lease agreement. Your application package may be emailed to D4Permits@dot.ca.gov. To download the permit application and to obtain more information on all required documentation, visit https://dot.ca.gov/programs/trafficoperations/ep/applications.
