Project Location (include county): The project is located at North Littlejohns Creek, in the County of San Joaquin, State of California; Latitude 37.915231, Longitude -121.212938 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees); Assessor's Parcel Numbers 179-220-54 and 179-220-50.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SJN-45699-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Greenlaw Development, LLC., as represented by Robert Mitchell.

The project is part of Phase 2 of the Mariposa Road Industrial Park project. This project is limited to the installation of a 16-inch diameter water line across North Littlejohns Creek. The water line will be installed under North Littlejohns Creek in the same location as an existing farm road crossing.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
