Project Location (include county): The Project is located at on two adjacent properties. The first is northeast of the El Toro Cut Off Road and Nichols Road intersection on Assessor's Parcel Number 347-090-008 hereinafter referred to as Site 1. The second property is within the County of Riverside's Mermack Avenue right-of-way in unincorporated Riverside County, State of California. The Project includes tributaries to Temescal Canyon Wash, which is a main tributary to the Santa Ana Watershed.
