Old barbed wire fencing and any other potential entanglement hazards must be removed from SMAs.) - Cultural Resources and Tribal Cultural Resources: (Archaeological monitoring be completed for all initial ground disturbing activities, this project shall occur within the designated footprint investigated by this report, the existing push pile to the right of the driveway at the entry to the property should be smoothed out and used as back fill for new construction during tribal monitoring and not be moved off parcel.)
