NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FROM CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

LEAD AGENCY: East Bay Regional Park District (EBRPD)

PROJECT TITLE: Coyote Hills: Well Replacement Project

PROJECT LOCATION: Coyote Hills Regional Park
8000 Patterson Ranch Rd, Fremont, CA 94555

PROJECT APPLICANT: EBRPD, 2950 Peralta Oaks Court, Oakland, CA 94605

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The purpose of the proposed project is to replace a well at Coyote Hills Regional Park. The well replacement consists of demolition of an existing well that is no longer functioning and construction of a new similar well. The replacement well will be approximately 350' deep (similar in size to the existing well) and will allow for continued irrigation of a small organic farm operation. The image below depicts the layout of the proposed project and staging of materials.

DETERMINATION: EBRPD has reviewed the proposed project and determined it to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to the following exemption:

Section 15302(c) Replacement or Reconstruction - The project consists of replacement of an existing well where the new well will be located on the same site as the existing well. The replacement well will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the well replaced.
