DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Conduct vegetation management activities at Caswell Memorial State Park (CMSP) to control the overgrown indigenous pests and non-native invasive plant species, Work will:

- In the 0 10' Zone: Remove all plants and shrubs 5' from road edges, campsites, and park facilities; and remove live and dead branches keeping a 10' distance from roofs and walls, and remove all leaves, needles, or other debris that fall in this zone;
- In the 5 30' Zone: Remove all dead plants, grass, and weeds up to 30' from facilities; actively prune live shrubs; and relocate large woody debris outside this zone and;
- In the 5 100' Zone: Create islands of vegetation with horizontal spacing between shrubs and trees; create vertical spacing between grass, shrubs, and trees; remove dead or dried vegetation; and trim trees regularly to maintain a minimum of 10' clearance between branches of adjoining trees and shrubs.
