Project Description:

The Department of Food and Agriculture, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Profession Code Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, is seeking to approve a Cannabis Cultivation License submitted on September 09, 2020, by Robert McKinley.

Project Activities:

The Project will consist of cannabis cultivation for a small indoor and nursery license type. Application LCA20-0002420 is located on parcel number 109-521-039-000 consisting of 7,549 square feet of indoor canopy with processing on site. The project site is located at an existing warehouse within a Light Industrial zoned area in the City of Greenfield. The project site is currently operating as a cannabis cultivation site and the application record indicates that project expansion will not occur. The project is categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA Class 1.
