The City of Watsonville is proposing the Lee Road Trail Project. The 1.43-mile-long trail would generally be a 12-foot-wide pedestrian/bicycle trail along the east side of Lee Road, with a 12-foot-wide pedestrian/bicycle bridge over the portion of Lee Road extending through (and submerged by) Struve Slough. Additionally, portions of the trail would extend along Harkins Slough Road on the north end to Pajaro Valley High School, along the west side of Lee Road on the south end to the rail trail, and along the unpaved path located on the north side of Watsonville Slough to existing trails on the east side of Highway 1.

Bio: Red legged frog construction monitoring plan, measures to avoid impacts to birds, bats, dusky-footed woodrats, fencing of sensitive areas, compensatory mitigation for habitat impacts, education and signage. Cultural: Construction Monitoring Plan for Cultural Resources and Human Remains, education, arch and native tribes monitors, and an Archaeological Treatment Plan.
