PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A Site Approval application to establish a breeding facility for a maximum of 10 dogs on site. The project include the construction of 6 kennels totaling 3,009 square-feet. The site utilizes an onsite well and septic system, and is accessed from E. Tokay Colony Rd. This parcel is under a Williamson Act contract. (Use Type: Animal Specialty Services – Kennels, Small Breeding)

The Property is zoned AG-40 (General Agriculture, 40-acre minimum) and the General Plan designation is A/G (General Agriculture).
