PROJECT LOCATION: The project site is located on the north side of E. Tokay Colony Rd., 1 mile east of Jack Tone Rd., Lodi, San Joaquin County. (APN/Address: 065-080-20 / 15045 East Tokay Colony Rd., Lodi) (Supervisorial District: 4)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A Site Approval application to establish a breeding facility for a maximum of 10 dogs on site. The project include the construction of 6 kennels totaling 3,009 square-feet. The site utilizes an onsite well and septic system, and is accessed from E. Tokay Colony Rd. This parcel is under a Williamson Act contract. (Use Type: Animal Specialty Services – Kennels, Small Breeding)

The Property is zoned AG-40 (General Agriculture, 40-acre minimum) and the General Plan designation is A/G (General Agriculture).
