NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND INTENT TO ADOPT AN INITIAL STUDY/NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE PROPOSED DONNER MEMORIAL STATE PARK ROAD AND TRAIL MANAGEMENT PLAN

Date: January 13, 2021

The California Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) has directed the preparation of and intends to adopt a Negative Declaration for the proposed project, in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and State CEQA Guidelines. DPR is the lead agency for the proposed project under CEQA.

PROJECT LOCATION: Donner Memorial State Park (DMSP) is located just east of the Sierra Nevada crest, along the Interstate 80 corridor, in Nevada and Placer counties.

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED PROJECT: DPR proposes to adopt a Road and Trail Management Plan describing the existing roads and trails of Donner Memorial State Park and providing specific direction for management and operations in the future.

PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD: The Initial Study/Negative Declaration is being circulated for public review and comment for a period of 30 days, beginning January 13, 2021.
