NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, August 17, 2021,** starting at **6:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Joint Chambers, 1010 10th Street, Basement Level, Modesto, California, to consider the following:

PLANNING COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATION OF APPROVAL FOR <u>GENERAL</u> <u>PLAN AMENDMENT AND REZONE APPLICATION NO. PLN2021-0001 – PARK</u> <u>PLACE RV STORAGE</u> – Request to amend the General Plan and zoning designations of two parcels, totaling 19.2 total acres in size, from Agriculture and A-2-40 (General Agriculture) to Planned Development (PD) to allow for the development of a recreational vehicle (RV) parking facility. The project site is located at 5150 McHenry Avenue (SR 108), between Kiernan Avenue and Charity Way, in the Modesto area.

The property is further identified as Assessor's Parcel No.: 074-015-016 and 074-015-017
