PROJECT TITLE: Lake Oroville Gate Project

LOCATION: Lake Oroville State Recreation Area COUNTY: Butte

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install eight (8) new metal gates at various entrances within Lake Oroville State Recreation Area to protect park resources, equipment, staff and public during disasters or other circumstances limit staffing presence.

The entrance gate install locations are:

- Loafer Creek Campground Entrance Road.
- Coyote Campground Entrance
- Loafer Creek Boat Launch
- Loafer Creek Day Use
- Loafer Creek Stage II Boat Ramp Access Road
- Bidwell Canyon Campground Entrance Road
- Gold Flat Campground
- Lime Saddle Day Use Entrance Road

Work will:

- Install eight (8) 30' to 36'x 3' x 4" metal barrier gates painted white with red reflective tape;
- Excavate sixteen (16) holes 4'x 16" to set metal post to secure gate and fill with concrete;
- Excavate sixteen (16) holes 24"x16" to secure gate it open position and fill with concrete;
- Trim vegetation to allow clearance of gates.

All gates will be manually operated with a center locking mechanism.
