DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Project will maintain backcountry roads by clearing vegetation from the prism of the roadway and the road shoulder. Additional work will address roadway erosion to maintain proper surface drainage. Maintenance of backcountry roads will improve access for ranger patrol and emergency response vehicles. Work will:

- Use chainsaw and loppers to clear vegetation from the roadway to a height of 14';
- Thin shrubs and trees less than 6" in diameter within up to 5' from each side of the road;
- Remove ladder fuels by pruning the branches on remaining trees and shrubs up to 10' above the ground;
- Lop and scatter material on site; and
- Use shovels and tampers to fill in ruts, remove berms, and maintain existing trail features.
