## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE ADELANTO SWITCHING STATION EXPANSION PROJECT

**Subject:** Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Adelanto Switching Station Expansion Project

An Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) has been prepared by the City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) for the proposed Adelanto Switching Station Expansion Project (Project). LADWP is the Lead Agency, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), responsible for preparation of this document.

**Project Description:** The proposed Project would occur within the existing approximate 315-acre fenced LADWP property. Currently located on the property are an existing switching station and converter station. As part of the proposed Project, a new converter station would be built adjacent to the existing converter station in order to upgrade and replace aging infrastructure. The existing converter station would be demolished once the new converter station is operational. The existing switching station would also be expanded to accommodate the new converter station and associated equipment. In addition, other Project components include transmission line relocation, construction of new towers, site preparation, and demolition of existing structures. The proposed Project is needed to upgrade and replace aging infrastructure and to allow LADWP greater control in managing the energy transfer along existing high voltage transmission lines and improve long-term reliability.

**Project Location:** The Project site is located on approximately 315 acres in the City of Adelanto, San Bernardino County, California. The Project site is completely fenced and is bounded by Raccoon Avenue to the west, Pansy Road to the south, and Daisy Road to the east. Rancho Road is located approximately 350 feet north of the Project site. Interstate 15 (I-15) is located approximately eight miles to the east of the Project site, United States Highway 395 (US-395) is approximately 1.5 miles to the east, and State Route 18 (SR-18) is approximately 3.5 miles to the south.

**Public Review Period:** The public comment period for the IS/MND will commence on February 10, 2021 and conclude on March 11, 2021. The IS/MND is available for review on the LADWP website at <u>http://www.ladwp.com/envnotices</u>.



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## **Environmental Effects**

The IS/MND describes potentially significant impacts to biological resources, cultural resources, geology and soils, hazards and hazardous materials, hydrology and water quality, noise, and transportation. Mitigation measures have been defined to reduce impacts to less than significant levels. Other effects found to be less than significant are also described in the IS/MND.

Per Section 15087(c)(6) of the CEQA Guidelines, the proposed Project site is not on any of the lists enumerated under Section 65962.5 of the California Government Code.
